RE: Goal 2.5: Safe, healthy, livable communities for all

Policies to Add:

- A. Support the development of Hawaiian Homes as a priority in West Maui.**
- B. Require county boards and commissions that make decisions regarding issues or development on West Maui hold meetings in West Maui throughout the entire decision-making process.**
- C. Support adequate and affordable preschool facilities and programs.**
- D. Promote the use of sustainable green building and development practices, such as the Leadership in energy and Environmental Design (LEED) standard.**

LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) is an internationally recognized green building certification system, providing third-party verification that a building or community was designed and built using strategies aimed at improving performance across all the metrics that matter most: energy savings, water efficiency, CO2 emissions reduction, improved indoor environmental quality, and stewardship of resources and sensitivity to their impacts.

- E. Encourage the provision of public restrooms in major parks and public spaces.**
- F. Promote and maintain the dark sky of the island by ensuring street lighting, building lighting and park lighting do not create excessive light pollution and glare.**
- G. Promote the placement of utilities underground in new area of development and in existing areas, where possible.**

Actions:

- A. Develop and construct fire, safety, and rescue services in Olowalu.**
- B. Develop an agreement with the DOE to open school grounds as neighborhood parks after school hours and on weekends.**

Edited Policy:

12. Support projects that provide housing for resident households earning 100 percent area median income (AMI) and below according to the need identified by **Stand-Up Maui in conjunction** with the Department of Housing and Human Concerns, and that are consistent with other Community Plan.
