Hi,  
I have visited the Napili area for over 30 years, and now live in a condo on Hui Road F. I noticed in the past few years the number of visitors driving in for the day to go to Napili Bay has increased to the point that the Lower Honoapiilani Road is packed with cars on either side of the street. Could you please have the committee consider making at least one side of the street "red" along this road so that cars can not park here. There is a parking lot near the Napili Surf and one a Kapalua for outside guests. The hotels have on-site parking for at least one car per unit in general already. It will help reduce the unsafe traffic and congestion and I also wonder if it will help keep the ocean and the coral healthier, by limiting the numbers that can come to this small bay. This idea was actually given to me by a full time resident in Napili. I feel like to keep the current atmosphere, we do not wider roads here either, just less cars. The area of congestion is near the intersections of Hui Road F and around by the Napili Kai Resort.

I decided that I would not attend tonight's meeting, but I have read through the plan and will get email updates. I am very happy to see that West Maui is thoughtfully addressing the concerns of the residents and environment.
